WINnovators – “Boosting entrepreneurial and STEM/STEAM capacity of young women in higher education institutions for sustainable development and innovation” is a European project funded by Erasmus+ programme. Officially launched in December 2021, the activities of the project will be carried out over the next 3 years.

The project aims at co-developing and implementing innovative teaching and learning approaches to concrete policies for capacity building in the digital, entrepreneurial, STEM/STEAM innovation and sustainability field. The main target groups and beneficiaries of these actions are especially young women from rural areas, students and teachers from HEIs (Higher Education Institutions).

The main goals of WINnovators project can be summarised as follows:

- Developing capacity building and practices across Partner countries;
- Enhancing young women’s skills and allowing HEI students and educators to become change agents, by developing gamified e-trainings and e-modules.
- Building a Community among WINnovators target groups, mediated by the interactive working space.
- Involving policy makers from all Partner countries, who will contribute to the creation of policy guidelines aimed at raising awareness and fostering gender-sensitive education at a European level.

The Consortium of the project is made of 7 Partners from 5 different countries: Estonia, Slovenia, Serbia, Italy and Romania.

The role of BADEN will consist in developing learning materials, organizing and running entrepreneurship-relevant courses for young women from rural areas of Serbia, and helping develop policies for training groups of such women.
